e-Learning programme for all staff and volunteers supporting children, young people and families in East Sussex

The following e-learning programme will help provide an introduction for all LSCB staff, including volunteers, to their roles and responsibilities in supporting children and young people to stay safe.

Safer Recruitment E Learning

This course has been put together by an organisation called EduCare – this organisation has 30 years experience of online learning; provides a wide range of courses; and has worked with the NSPCC for some time.

This course will take you through the whole process: from planning prior to recruitment to maintaining vigilance once the new recruit is a member of your organisation.

The course is split into 4 modules that cover:

Preparing to recruit

This module examines what a safer recruitment process is and covers the steps that you should take when preparing to recruit.

Selecting the right people

This module details what a safer selection process looks like and it explores the key elements.

Vetting checks

This module covers what you need to know about vetting checks and the legal situation. There is a section on overseas applicants, the necessity of taking up references, looking at qualifications and identity documents, as well as self-disclosure.

Maintaining vigilance

This module looks at the importance of on-going awareness and vigilance once the person you have recruited is in place. There is also a section on whistleblowing and promoting an open culture.
