Course Aims and Description

This course will enable professionals to explore current research and practice in relation to children and young people's use of mobile technologies:

- explore how children use technology
- address the benefits alongside the risks
- explore different methods of keeping children safe
- identify various resources and tools available
- identify the added risks for vulnerable children e.g. children with learning disabilities.

Target Audience

This course is aimed at all front line professionals, including managers from East Sussex County Council Children's Services Social Care, Early Help, Children's Services Education, Schools, Adult Services, and Youth Offending Team. East Sussex Police, Health, Probation and the Voluntary and Independent sectors.

A maximum of three representatives from each team may have a confirmed place and further applications will be put on a wait list.
